



KARMA DRAMA -

A Karmic Biography

a talk with Mike Chase at Sophia House 7 pm Sat. 18 Jan 2025


Mike will give a talk demonstrating the process and outcome of his research into karma and past lives. Mike had a breakthrough in past-life research several years ago while working in a therapeutic prison with violent male offenders.

The past life exercises brought him imaginations, and intuitions of past lives and the karmic relationships playing out in distant times and faraway places. While working with these insights, relationships with colleagues and residents started improving. He could see the fruitfulness of this work and began practicing daily.

His talk will focus on different exercises by Rudolf Steiner and ways of entering artistic processes including masks to come to karmic imaginations and intuitions of past lives. Participants of his work have described how they are beginning to harmonise unresolved karma in the depths of the soul and obtaining more clarity and insight into what has led them to their present life and what steps need to be taken into the future.

This is a dynamic, interactive talk using processes of embodiment. The following weekends 24th to 26th January and 7th to 9th February, he will be running a workshop on a number of these processes, also at Sophia House, 18 Firfield Road, Plumstead, Cape Town.

Karma Drama Summer 2025

Two weekend workshops through Art and Drama 24th to 26th January 7th to 9th February at Sophia House,18 Firfield Road, Plumstead, Cape Town.

Mike Chase, psychodrama psychotherapist and teacher, and

Angela Katschke, art therapist and consultant

are combining forces to bring 2 unique workshops around biography and karma to you. Both have been interested in the work of Rudolf Steiner and their very own work finds plenty of inspiration from Anthroposophy, dedicated to spiritual science.

Researching past lives and karma through safe and effective karma exercises inspired by Rudolf Steiner

There are a number of very affective past life and karma research exercises which enable one to go back into past lives. This gives us perspective on our present life situation, our relationships, family, colleagues and purpose to take on what life is asking of us. Karma work helps us to prepare for the future and take our destiny on more consciously. These processes are deep, playful and transformative.

Workshop 1, The Biographical-Karma Exercise: Friday - Sunday 24th to 26th January

The Biographical Karma Exercise by Jostein Saether and Mike Chase has been developed from Rudolf Steiner's indications around the Imaginary Life Tableau. Using biographical moments from our lives and going back through seven-year cycles to our first memory we can establish our life tableau. By going further back in time to birth and conception through moral imagination, takes us into the soul world. This moral imagination of the journey before birth, and after the death of a previous life, enables us to step into a previous incarnation.

Through artistic processes of drawing, moving, and mask work followed by imaginative meditations through the soul and sprit worlds, we are enabled to go back to a previous life we had on earth. This process is to take on our karma consciously to prepare for our present and future tasks on earth.

Workshop 2, Karma-Drama and Destiny Learning:

Friday - Sunday 7th to 9th February

Another profound and far-reaching karma research process is that of Destiny Learning. Founded by Koen van Houten, the invitation of Destiny Learning is to acquaint oneself with our karmic double, a shadow side of our being which wants to be transformed. Through the process of small group work we are invited to take hold of our doubles and enter an intimate process of transforming it. This leads us to the origin story behind this double which inevitably arises in a past incarnation.

Through artistic processes of drawing, moving, and mask work followed by imaginative meditations and supportive group processes, we are enabled to go back to a previous life we had on earth. During this process we will be using embodiment exercises and masks to identify past life personalities and determine what they are asking of us today. This process helps to take on our karma more consciously and to take hold of aspects of our double which keep raising their heads at the cost to ourselves and others.

talk by Angus Jenkinson on Friday 17th January at 9 pm SA time. Hosted by the London Branch. This talk draws on Angus's book, *From Stress to Serenity, Gaining*

strength in the trials of life. To be born inevitably means finding oneself in a life likely to seem stressful. This is worse still when the meaning of life is lost and we find ourselves separated from nature. The deepest stress lies in the loss of true self-knowledge. Curiously, many of the difficulties become keys to discovery, as in the fire trial. Karma can be another source of stress, difficulties that we have paradoxically chosen for ourselves. Angus will explore these and other aspects of how to deal with stress on the journey to Christ and the angelic self. On this journey, we learn to take responsibility for our own inner life.
